For children between 3 and 5 years

We are registered with the Local Education Authority and Ofsted. As such we are entitled to claim Early Years funding for children in the term after they are three years old. Our fees for this age group take this into consideration. Please contact the School for more details.

For children over 5 years

The fees applicable for 2011/12 will be available on request.

Fees for the first younger brother and/or sister will be reduced by 20%, and for a third sibling by 35%.

School hours are 9.15 a.m. to 3.30 p.m. (12.00 p.m. mornings only) in Children's House, and 9.00 a.m. to 3.30 p.m. in Primary. Attendance outside of these hours (day care) can be arranged and is charged at £5 per hour block or part thereof. Day care fees vary according to the number of weeks in a term.

Fees are due on the first day of each term. To operate efficiently, the School requires a full term's notice (i.e. on or before the first day of term) in writing of a child ceasing to attend, or a term's fees must be paid in lieu.
